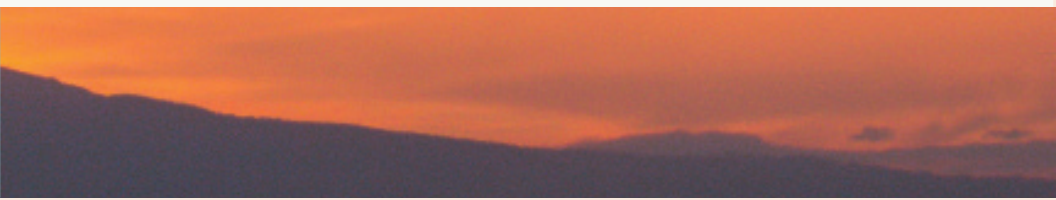

## ASSISTANT LEADERS

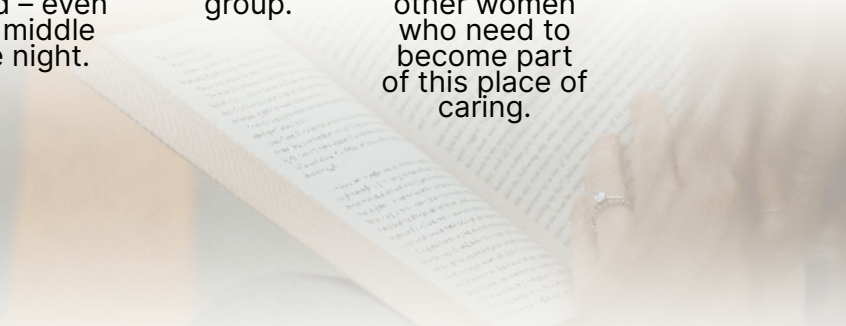
To strive to identify and help develop assistant leaders in our group.

# PRAYERS TO RECEIVE CHRIST

If you would like to accept the free gift of eternal life, you can acknowledge Christ as your Savior and receive Him into your heart right now by praying a simple prayer.

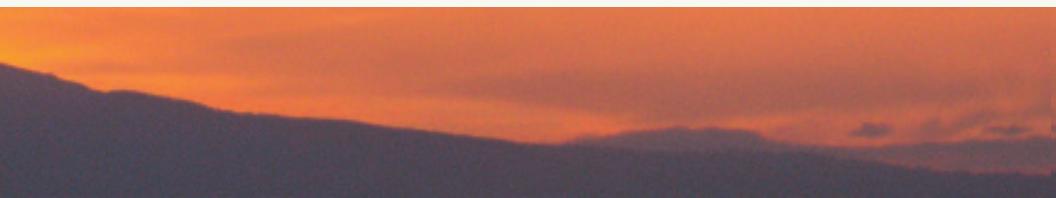
Your prayer does not need to be long, complicated or elaborate. It only needs to be sincere.

Lord Jesus, I realize I am a sinner and that I am powerless to save myself. I acknowledge that You are the Son of God and You have already paid the debt for my sins. I realize that You died for me. You accepted the punishment for every single one of my sins (past sins, present sins and future sins) when You hung upon the cross.

I accept the gift of eternal life offered to me through your sacrificial death. Come into my heart and dwell in me, Jesus. Wash me clean. Thank you, God, in advance that You will never leave me or forsake me. I am Yours forever.

In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.

Lord Jesus, I need you. Thank you for dying on the cross for my sins. I open my heart and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Thank you for forgiving my sins and giving me eternal life. Take control of the throne of my life. Make me the kind of person you want me to be.

In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.

If at some point in your life you sincerely prayed to receive Christ as your Savior, but you still doubt if you are a child of God. Pray something like this:

God, You have said, "to all who receive Jesus, to those who believe in His Name, He gives the right to become children of God." I have opened my heart, invited Jesus to come and live within me, and I believe by faith based on Your Word that I have received Him. I believe He is the Lord Jesus Christ, with all that is implied by His Name. Therefore, based on Your own Word, by faith I am claiming my rights.
